A Word from our President and CEO

Loving What I Do - It's the Why That Matters

In a recent conversation with my husband he commented, "No matter how busy you are with your job, you always love what you do." This accurately sums up my almost 29 years with Columbus Hospice of Georgia and Alabama – and how lucky am I!

So what makes my job so satisfying? I have a clear understanding that the work of this organization changes lives – every day – in ways large and small. Since 1979, Columbus Hospice has cared for those with terminal illnesses in the Chattahoochee Valley and beyond. Team members, including the Board of Directors, Staff, and Volunteers, understand and support our mission of caring for our community, including those who do not have insurance coverage.

Over this past year, you might have heard of our Care Campaign. This fundraising campaign has already raised \$880,000 toward uncompensated care for 2023, yet the need is projected to be around \$1.5 million by the end of December. Donations, grants, and fundraisers from the Care Campaign provide funds so that no eligible Columbus Hospice patient will be turned away from care due to a lack of insurance, inadequate insurance coverage, or benefits that run out when care is still needed.

One exciting addition to the Columbus Hospice campus is The Legacy Brick Circle. Besides providing a beautiful and accessible way to remember special people and special events (memorials, in honor of, birthdays, weddings, anniversaries, retirement – whatever is important to you), The Legacy Circle proceeds will go to the Care Campaign, directly to patient care needs. Sales just started, and when complete, \$1,233,000 will be raised. Still available for naming opportunities are a \$25,000 center tree, 4 benches at \$10,000 each, 8x8 brick pavers, and 4x8 brick pavers. With a purchase, you might also add a mini-brick to keep for yourself.

Columbus Hospice is the only non-profit, independent hospice in the Columbus and surrounding area. We have the only local inpatient hospice facility, although most of our patient care is provided in homes and long-term care facilities in our 16-county coverage area (including 5 counties in Alabama.) We know how important high-quality, accessible, innovative, expert hospice care is, and Columbus Hospice of Georgia and Alabama is proud and honored to care for you and your family. And now you know why I love what I do!

Bricks are available as memorials or gifts for all celebratory occasions, such as anniversaries, birthdays, graduations and more.






